AN ORDINANCE ' 99904

ACCEPTING A DONATION OF MODULAR FURNITURE VALUED AT \$41,000.00 FROM RANDOLPH BROOKS FEDERAL CREDIT UNION TO THE SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT TO BE USED TO FURNISH THE NEWLY EXPANDED NORTH, NORTHWEST, AND EAST SUBSTATIONS.

**WHEREAS**, Randolph Brooks Federal Credit Union desires to donate used modular furniture to the San Antonio Police Department as a community initiative; and

**WHEREAS**, the modular furniture consists of forty-one (41) used steel case workstations in good condition and will be used to furnish the newly expanded North, Northwest, and East substations; and

**WHEREAS**, the costs to deliver and install the modular furniture totals \$10,862.27 and will be expended from Asset Seizure Funds; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The Interim City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept a donation of used modular furniture from Randolph Brooks Federal Credit Union to the San Antonio Police Department which will be used to furnish the newly expanded North, Northwest, and East substations. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute any and all documentation necessary to effect said acceptance.

**SECTION 2.** Funds in the amount of \$10,862.27 are authorized to be encumbered in cost center 1711020001 "Miscellaneous Special Revenue", General Ledger 5201040 entitled "Fees to Professional Services", Fund 29038000 entitled "Confiscated Property New State Account" when a purchase order is issued.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or his designee, correct allocations to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.


