AN ORDINANCE 99903

ACCEPTING A \$3,000.00 PRIZE FROM ITT INDUSTRIES THAT WAS AWARDED TO THE SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT SWAT TEAM FOR WINNING THE 2004 WORLD SWAT CHALLENGE, WHICH WILL BE USED FOR CONTINUING TRAINING AND PROFICIENCY EXERCISES; AMENDING THE BUDGET; AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the World SWAT Challenge is an invitation only World Championship competition designed to challenge the fitness, motivation, tactical and weapons skills of the world's top SWAT teams; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Police Department SWAT team took top honors in a national competition held in May, 2004; and

WHEREAS, ITT Industries, a company that specializes in night vision devices for military and law enforcement applications, was a prize sponsor for the event and has awarded the San Antonio Police Department SWAT Team a \$3,000.00 prize donation; and

WHEREAS, the \$3,000.00 prize donation will be used to fund continuing training and proficiency exercises for the SWAT Team; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept a prize donation of \$3,000.00 from ITT Industries to the San Antonio Police Department SWAT Team which will be used to fund continuing training and proficiency

exercises for the SWAT Team. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute any and all documentation necessary to effect said acceptance.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 99725, the Budget Ordinance, is authorized to be revised in accordance with Section 1.

SECTION 3. Funds in the amount of \$3,000.00 are authorized to be deposited in Fund 11001000 (General Fund), Cost Center 1704080001, General Ledger 5207010 entitled "Maintenance & Repair Commercial".

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or his designee, correct allocations to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
