

AN ORDINANCE            999 23

**AUTHORIZING AND RATIFYING A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH CLEAR CHANNEL OUTDOOR, INC., TO PROVIDE THE ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT WITH OUTDOOR BILLBOARD ADVERTISEMENT SPACE FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$30,001.00 TO PROMOTE THE CITY'S CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance Number 99144, passed and approved on May 14, 2004, authorized the City to accept from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), a municipal solid waste pass-through grant, administered by the Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG), to promote the City's curbside recycling program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Environmental Services Department wishes to partner with the American Beverage Association (ABA) by expending \$30,001.00 of the above mentioned grant for payment for advertising space on two existing billboards, which services are presently being provided as necessary to secure available billboard space;   **NOW THEREFORE;**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The services provided by Clear Channel Outdoor, Inc., to promote the City's curbside recycling program, through the display of two existing billboards, located at the intersections of Interstate Highway 35 South and Splashtown Drive, and Interstate Highway 10 West and Vance Jackson, respectively, are hereby ratified.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager, Interim City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a Purchase Agreement between the City and Clear Channel Outdoor, Inc., appearing in substantially the same form as Attachment I affixed hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes, adjusted as may be required by the Office of the City Attorney, to provide the Environmental Services Department with outdoor billboard advertisement space to promote the City's curbside recycling program, for total consideration of \$30,001.00.

**SECTION 3.** Purchases pursuant to this agreement will be made from Fund 26008000, Internal Order 155000000011, entitled "Recycling And Green Waste Education Program Phase II". The sum of \$30,001.00 is hereby encumbered to be payable to Clear Channel

Outdoor, Inc., in SAP GL Account No. 5203040 for expenses promoting The City's curbside recycling program.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, Interim City Manager, or his designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** The execution authority granted shall expire on October 29, 2004. If the subject contract is not executed within 30 (thirty) days of the Council action date (October 21, 2004) in a form acceptable to the City, authority to execute the contract shall terminate.

**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall be effective on October 31, 2004.
