

AN ORDINANCE            9 9 9 6 3

**AUTHORIZING THE REPROGRAMMING OF FY 2002 HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH AIDS (HOPWA) GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000.00 AVAILABLE FROM BLACK EFFORT AGAINST THE THREAT OF AIDS, INC. (BEAT-AIDS) AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION AND ALLOCATION OF SAID FUNDS TO SAN ANTONIO AIDS FOUNDATION (SAAF) TO PROVIDE TENANT BASED RENTAL ASSISTANCE (TBRA) TO INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE HIV/AIDS AND THEIR FAMILY MEMBERS; AUTHORIZING THE REPROGRAMMING OF FY 2004 HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH AIDS (HOPWA) GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000.00 AVAILABLE FROM THE SAAF AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION AND ALLOCATION OF SAID FUNDS TO BEAT-AIDS TO RENOVATE A FACILITY FOR LONG TERM HOUSING FOR SINGLE WOMEN AND WOMEN WITH CHILDREN INFECTED OR AFFECTED BY HIV/AIDS; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSE-OUT AND THE CANCELLATION OF THE AFFECTED PROJECTS AND PROJECT BUDGETS; REVISING APPROPRIATE PROJECT BUDGETS; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND SUBMISSION OF CONTRACTS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS AS NECESSARY IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, in the administration of the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS Grant (HOPWA) Program, funds available in previously-appropriated projects may, pursuant to regulations of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), be retained by grantees for reprogramming to provide supplementation to existing projects and/or funding in support of new programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is a HOPWA fund grantee; and

**WHEREAS**, in connection with the current HOPWA Programs, the sum of \$100,000.00 is currently available in FY 2002 HOPWA funds, and the sum of \$100,000.00 is currently available in FY 2004 HOPWA funds for said reprogramming and allocation; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to applicable HUD regulations, statutory requirements and/or City Council policy designed to ensure adequate citizen input, a public hearing is required prior to any reprogramming of or modification to HOPWA funds and projects, respectively and prior to the adoption of activities under the City's Community Development Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the required notice having been duly published, and said public hearing having been held before City Council on November 4, 2004, it is now the desire of the City to formally resolve the issues of allocating reprogrammable HOPWA funds; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Revisions to the FY 2002 and FY 2004 Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS Grant (HOPWA) projects and the modifications to the budgets and reprogramming in support thereof in the amounts of \$100,000.00 each are hereby approved in accordance with the budget schedule affixed hereto and incorporated by reference herein for all purposes as Attachment I. Said FY 2002 funds are hereby authorized to be reprogrammed to aid in funding the San Antonio Aids Foundation (SAAF) to provide Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) to persons living with HIV/AIDS and their family members, and said FY 2004 funds are hereby authorized to be reprogrammed to aid in funding the Black Effort Against the Threat of Aids, Inc. (BEAT-AIDS) to renovate a facility for long term housing for single women and women with children infected with HIV/AIDS, in accordance with Attachment I.

**SECTION 2.** The appropriations of funds and the budget revision necessitated and scheduled pursuant to the aforesaid Attachment I are hereby authorized for entry into the City's accounting system.

**SECTION 3.** The Director of the City's Finance Department is hereby authorized to effect on the books of the City the cancellations, revisions and reprogramming in support thereof, set forth in Attachment I. The Interim City Manager, or his designee or City's Director of Community Initiatives is hereby authorized to execute any and all contracts and other documents as necessary for (a) implementation of the reductions, revisions and reprogramming set forth in Attachment I and (b) compliance with HUD rules, regulations and procedures, and to submit all certifications and such other information to and as required by HUD.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or his designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, and SAP WBS Elements as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall be effective on and after the 14th day of November, 2004.


