

AN ORDINANCE 99956

THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR THE UTSA IN CONNECTION WITH THE UTSA TRIATHLON SPONSORED BY ROGER SOLER SPORTS TO BE HELD ON SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2004 FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 10:00 A.M.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by **Roger Soler Sports** to hold the “UTSA Triathlon” on Sunday, November 14, 2004 from 7:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

Assembly Area

UTSA Pool

Route

Start at UTSA Pool,
Exit Pool Parking Lot ,
Eastbound on Margaret Tobin to John Peace,
Northbound on John Peace to Highway (Loop) 1604 Access,
Eastbound on Highway (Loop) 1604 Access to Valero,
Southbound on Valero to UTSA,
Westbound on UTSA to Babcock,
Northbound on Babcock to Highway (Loop) 1604 Access,
Eastbound on Highway (Loop) 1604 to Valero,
Southbound on Valero to UTSA,
Westbound on UTSA to Babcock,
Northbound on Babcock to Highway (Loop) 1604 Access to Chase Hill,
Southbound on Chase Hill to Margaret Tobin,
Westbound on Margaret Tobin to UTSA Pool Parking Lot.

Bikes will circle route twice.

SECTION 3. **Roger Soler Sports** shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio’s Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 4. **Roger Soler Sports** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold

harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective on November 14, 2004.
