

AN ORDINANCE 99955

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR THE ALAMODOME IN CONNECTION WITH THE SAN ANTONIO MARATHON 5K FITNESS CHALLENGE AND WALK SPONSORED BY THE SAN ANTONIO MARATHON COMMITTEE TO BE HELD ON SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2004 FROM 6:00 A.M. UNTIL 1:00 P.M.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by the **S.A. Marathon Committee** to hold the "San Antonio Marathon, 5K Fitness Challenge and Walk" on Sunday, November 7, 2004 from 6:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

5K Assembly Area

Northbound Highway U.S. 281 Frontage Road between Montana and Commerce

5K Route

South on Northbound U.S. Highway 281 Frontage Road to Durango (Total Closure),
West on Durango to Alamo (Total Closure),
North on Alamo to Market (2 right lanes)
East on Market to Bowie (2 right lanes),
South on Bowie to Durango Street Turnaround (Total Closure),
North on Northbound Adams Freeway Access to Commerce (Total Closure),
West on Commerce to Bowie (2 left lanes),
South on Bowie to Pedestrian Walkway (Total Closure),
East on Pedestrian Walkway to finish in North Plaza of the Alamodome.

Half Marathon Assembly Area

Northbound U.S. Highway 281 Frontage Road between Montana and Commerce

West on Durango to Alamo (Total Closure),
North on Alamo to Market (2 right lanes),
East on Market to Bowie (2 right lanes),
South on Bowie to Durango Street Turnaround (Total Closure),

North on Adams Freeway Access (U.S. Highway 281 Northbound Access Road) to Commerce (Total Closure),
West on Commerce to Rosillo (2 left lanes from U.S. Northbound Highway 281 Frontage Road to Rosillo),
South on Rosillo to Buena Vista (Total Closure),
East on Buena Vista to Frio (2 right lanes),
South on Frio to Alamo (2 right lanes),
South on Alamo to Main (2 Northbound Lanes for runners-No Northbound Traffic),
North on Main to Guenther (2 Northbound Lanes for runners-No Northbound Traffic),
South on Guenther to Eagleland (Total Closure),
East on Eagleland to St. Marys (Total Closure),
South on St. Marys to turn around back North to St. Marys (Total Closure)
North on St. Marys to Alamo (Total Closure),
North on Alamo to Durango (Northbound Lanes for runners-Southbound Lanes for traffic),
East on Durango to Cherry (Runners in Eastbound Lanes until Interstate Highway 37 Southbound Frontage Road; then cross runners to Westbound lanes of Durango),
North on Cherry to Nolan (Total Closure),
West on Nolan to Southbound Access of U.S. Highway 281 (Runners in Eastbound Lanes of Noland-Traffic in Westbound Lanes),
South on Southbound Access of U.S. Highway 281 to Starr (Total Closure),
West on Starr to Bowie (Total Closure),
South on Bowie to Dome Walkway (Runners In Southbound Lanes),
South on Walkway to North Plaza (**Finish**)

North on Adams Freeway Access (U.S. Highway 281 Northbound Access Road) to Commerce (Total Closure),
West on Commerce to Rosillo (2 left lanes from Northbound U.S. Highway 281 Frontage Road to Rosillo),
South on Rosillo to Buena Vista (Total Closure),
East on Buena Vista to Frio (2 right lanes),
South on Frio to Alamo (2 right lanes),
South on Alamo to Main (2 Northbound Lanes),
North on Main to Guenther (Total Northbound Closure),
South on Guenther to Eagleland (Total Closure),
East on Eagleland to St. Marys (Total Closure),
South on St. Marys to Mission (Total Closure),
South on Mission to Turnaround and return Northbound on Mission (Total Closure),

North on Mission to St. Marys (Total Closure),
North on St. Marys to Alamo (Northbound Closure),
North on Alamo to Durango (Northbound Lanes for runners-Southbound Lanes for traffic),
East on Durango to Cherry (Runners in Eastbound Lanes until Interstate Highway 37 Southbound Frontage then cross runners to Westbound Lanes of Durango),
North on Cherry to Nolan (Total Closure),
West on Nolan to Southbound Access Road of U.S. Highway 281 (Runners in Eastbound Lanes of Nolan-traffic in Westbound Lanes),
South on Southbound U.S. Highway 281 Access to Starr (Total Closure),
West on Starr to Bowie (Total Closure),
South on Bowie to Market (Total Closure),
East on Market to Northbound Access Road of U.S. Highway 281 (2 Right Lane Closure),
South on Northbound Access Road of U.S. Highway 281 to Durango (Total Closure),
West on Durango to Alamo (Westbound Total Closure),
North on Alamo to Market (2 Right Lane Closure),
East on Market to Bowie (2 Right Lane Closure),
South on Walkway

SECTION 3. The S.A. Marathon Committee shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 4. The S.A. Marathon Committee shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately, upon passage by eight (8) or more affirmative votes.


