

AN ORDINANCE 100019

AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURES OF WEST EVERGREEN BETWEEN SAN PEDRO AVENUE AND MAVERICK STREET IN CONNECTION WITH THE 15TH ANNUAL PEACE MARKET SPONSORED BY ESPERANZA PEACE AND JUSTICE CENTER TO BE HELD ON FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 26 AND SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 27, 2004 FROM 8:00 A.M. UNTIL 7:00 P.M.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The temporary street closure as requested by Esperanza Peace and Justice Center to hold the "15th Annual Peace Market" on Friday, November 26 and Saturday, November 27, 2004 from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure of West Evergreen between San Pedro Avenue and Maverick Street to vehicular traffic is hereby authorized during the event:

SECTION 3. The City Manager, Interim City Manager, or the designee of either is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

SECTION 4. Esperanza Peace and Justice Center shall be responsible for the following:

- a) all insurance requirements,
- b) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges,
- c) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and
- d) cleaning the area after the event is held.


SECTION 5. Esperanza Peace and Justice Center shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective immediately if it receives eight affirmative votes. Otherwise, it shall be effective on the 28th November, 2004.
