

AN ORDINANCE **100000**

ACCEPTING THE LOW RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED BY DONSAN CONSTRUCTION, L.L.C. (MBE), TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT WITH THE INSTALLATION OF A SANITARY SEWER LINE AT THE SAN FERNANDO GYMNASIUM FACILITY FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$80,000.00 FROM 30TH YEAR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Parks & Recreation Department with the installation of a sanitary sewer line at the San Fernando Gymnasium Facility; and

WHEREAS, the low bid was submitted by Donsan Construction, L.L.C. (MBE) for a total amount of \$80,000.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid submitted by Donsan Construction, L.L.C. (MBE) to provide the City of San Antonio Parks & Recreation Department with the installation of a sanitary sewer line at the San Fernando Gymnasium Facility for a total amount of \$80,000.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the successful bidder's completion of all conditions precedent to award or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. Attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A is the bid and bid tabulation sheet.

SECTION 2. Funding will be appropriated in Project Definition 26-00246 entitled "San Fernando Gymnasium Facility Project" for the above mentioned construction.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$80,000.00 is authorized to be encumbered in WBS Element No.26-00246-05-08 entitled "Construction Costs" and made payable to Donsan Construction LLC.

SECTION 4. Funding for the above mentioned construction will be from SAP Fund 2803000, entitled "CDBG 30th Year Funding".

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or the Interim City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Internal Orders and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect November 28th, 2004.


