AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500.00 FROM WAL-MART #1198 TO THE NORTH SAN ANTONIO FEAR FREE ENVIRONMENT UNIT OF THE SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT TO BE USED TO PURCHASE FINGERPRINT KITS FOR IDENTIFYING CHILDREN; EDUCATIONAL SUPPLIES; AND BROCHURES RELATED TO CHILD SAFETY, BIKE RODEOS, ELDERLY SCAMS, AND SAFETY TIPS FOR THE ELDERLY; AMENDING THE BUDGET; AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Wal-Mart #1198 wishes to donate \$500.00 to the North San Antonio Fear Free Environment (SAFFE) Unit of the San Antonio Police Department; and

WHEREAS, said funds will be used to purchase fingerprint kits for identifying children; educational supplies; and brochures related to child safety, bike rodeos, elderly scams, and safety tips for the elderly; and

WHEREAS, no matching contribution is required of the City in accepting the aforementioned donation; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept a donation in the amount of \$500.00 from Wal-Mart #1198 to the North San Antonio Fear Free Environment (SAFFE) Unit of the San Antonio Police Department to be used to purchase fingerprint kits for identifying children; educational supplies; and brochures related to child safety, bike rodeos, elderly scams, and safety tips for the elderly.

SECTION 2. Funds in the amount of \$500.00 are authorized to be deposited in cost center 1702100001, general ledger 5302010 (Commodities–Office Supplies), fund 11001000 (General Fund) when received. Budget in the amount of \$500.00 is authorized to be appropriated in cost center 1702100001, general ledger 5302010 (Commodities– Office Supplies), fund 11001000 (General Fund).

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager’s designee, correct allocations to specific cost centers, WBS elements, internal orders, general ledger accounts, and funds as necessary to carry out the purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
