

AN ORDINANCE 100097

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE (TDCJ) AND THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO FOR THE PROVISION OF DEATH CERTIFICATES TO TDCJ OF PAROLEES WHO PASS AWAY WHILE ON PAROLE AND FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,200.00 FOR THE PERIOD SEPTEMBER 1, 2004 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2005.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio, through the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD), currently provides comprehensive public health services to protect the health of all residents within the jurisdiction of the SAMHD; and

WHEREAS, the SAMHD Statistical Services/Vital Statistics Registry Division provides birth and death certificates for Bexar County; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) desires to contract with the City of San Antonio in order for the SAMHD to provide death certificates to TDCJ of parolees who pass away while they are on parole; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize the execution of the contract for the provision of these death certificates; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute a contract for the period September 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005 in an amount not to exceed \$1,200.00 with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice for the SAMHD to provide death certificates to TDCJ of parolees who pass away while they are on parole. A copy of the contract, in substantially correct form, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. The proceeds of these agreements shall be deposited into Fund 11-000 entitled "General Fund," Index Code 014282, entitled, "Birth & Death Certificates."

SECTION 3. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or the Interim City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific internal order numbers, account numbers and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective on and after December 19, 2004.
