

AN ORDINANCE 100076

ACCEPTING THE LOW RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED BY CUSTOM SALES & SERVICE, INC. (WBE) TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO COMMUNITY INITIATIVES DEPARTMENT WITH A CONCEPT VAN TO DELIVER MEALS FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE NUTRITION PROGRAM FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$37,000.00.

WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Community Initiatives Department with a concept van to assist in the delivery of meals for the Comprehensive Nutrition Program; and

WHEREAS, the low bid was submitted by Custom Sales & Service, Inc., a WBE, for a total amount of \$37,000.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid submitted by Custom Sales & Service, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Community Initiatives Department with a concept van for a total amount of \$37,000.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the successful bidder's completion of all conditions precedent to award or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. Attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A is the bid and bid tabulation sheet.

SECTION 2. Funding for one four door extended cab concept van has been set out in accounting in Fund Center No. 3803260000, entitled "Comprehensive Nutrition Program 2004-2005".

SECTION 3. The amount of \$37,000.00 is to be encumbered and made payable to Custom Sales & Service, Inc. from Fund Center No. 3803260000, Internal Order No. 138000000291 in GL account 5501050.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or the Interim City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Internal Order Numbers, Fund Numbers and GL Account numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect December 19, 2004.
