

AN ORDINANCE 100169

**APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS IN CONNECTION WITH THE 2005 MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. MARCH AND CELEBRATION PROGRAM TO BE HELD FROM 8:00 A.M. UNTIL 5:00 P.M. MONDAY, JANUARY 17, 2005.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby approves the requested parade permit to the City of San Antonio's Martin Luther King Jr. Commission to hold the "2005 Martin Luther King, Jr. March and Celebration Program" on Monday January 17, 2005 from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

**SECTION 2.** In order to hold the "2005 Martin Luther King, Jr. March and Celebration Program" on Monday, January 17, 2004, the following streets listed below are hereby authorized to be closed to vehicular traffic:

Celebration Program/Preparation of Stage: Pittman Sullivan Park at 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Monday January 17, 2005. All activities associated with the celebration will terminate at 5:00 p.m.

Parade Route: Beginning January 17, 2005 at 8:00 a.m. Assemble at 3500 Martin Luther King, travel west on Martin Luther King, south on New Braunfels to Iowa, west on Iowa to Pittman Sullivan Park.

Street Closures: Beginning Monday, January 17, 2005 at 8:00 a.m. Palmetto between Iowa and Dakota, Nevada between New Braunfels and Palmetto, and Dakota between New Braunfels and Palmetto will be closed for VIA Park and Ride service and parking for buses and reopened following the event. Residents that live on Palmetto will be allowed to exit and enter their homes, but will not be able to park on the street itself.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

**SECTION 4.** City of San Antonio shall be responsible for the following:

- a) all insurance requirements,
- b) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges,
- c) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police

- Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and
- d) cleaning the area after the event is held.


**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall be effective on December 26, 2004.
