

AN ORDINANCE 100138

ACCEPTING THE LOW RESPONSIVE BID
SUBMITTED BY PHILPOTT MOTORS, LTD. TO
PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO FIRE
DEPARTMENT WITH A BOMB EVIDENCE
COLLECTION VAN FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$91,800.00,
FROM STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT
FUNDS.

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WHEREAS, a bid was submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with a custom manufactured bomb evidence collection van; and

WHEREAS, the van will be utilized as a mobile lab to conduct on-site detection and investigative work, and will be used by the Fire Department's arson division when responding to weapons of mass destruction, terrorist and/or arson related incidents; and

WHEREAS, the bid was submitted by Philpott Motors, Ltd. for a total amount of \$91,800.00; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid submitted by Philpott Motors, Ltd. to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with a bomb evidence collection van for a total amount of \$91,800.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. Attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A is the bid and bid tabulation sheet.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$91,800.00 is approved for purchase of the Fire Department's Arson Division Bomb evidence collection van as appropriated in existing SAP Fund 26065000, entitled "State Homeland Security Grant".

SECTION 3. The amount of \$91,800.00 is encumbered and payable to Philpott Motors, Ltd. in SAP Fund 26065000, Internal Order No. 120000000010 for the above said Bomb evidence collection van.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or the Interim City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers and Internal orders as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect December 26^h, 2004.


