

AN ORDINANCE 100965

REALLOCATING \$9,050.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 3 FY 2004-2005 ONE-TIME PROJECT FUNDS DESIGNATED TO THE OLD CORPUS CHRISTI ROAD SEWER LATERAL PROJECT FOR THE FOLLOWING: \$3,000.00 TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT FOR ADDITIONAL BRUSH PICKUP; \$2,250.00 TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO HELP OFFSET THE COST FOR A SHOWMOBILE FOR ST. LEO THE GREAT FESTIVAL HELD ON SEPTEMBER 5, 2004, SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO CHURCH FESTIVAL HELD ON OCTOBER 16, 2004 AND THE ST. LAWRENCE CATHOLIC CHURCH FESTIVAL HELD ON MAY 7, 2005; \$1,300.00 TO THE UNITED STATES MILITARY VETERANS PARADE ASSOCIATION TO OFFSET THE COST FOR BARRICADE EXPENSES IN CONNECTION WITH ITS ANNUAL PARADE HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2004; AND \$2,500.00 TO THE AMERICAN OPPORTUNITY FOR HOUSING, INC., TO BE USED AS CAPITAL FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF A CHILD CARE FACILITY AT THE RESERVE AT PECAN VALLEY APARTMENT COMPLEX; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN RON SEGOVIA, DISTRICT 3.

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WHEREAS, Councilman Ron Segovia has requested Council concurrence for the reallocation of \$9,050.00 of District 3 One Time Projects budget from the completed Old Corpus Christi Sewer Lateral Project for the fiscal year 2004-2005; and

WHEREAS, the requested funds are to be transferred as follows:

- \$3,000.00 to the Environmental Services Department for additional brush pickup;
- \$2,250.00 to the Parks and Recreation Department to help offset the cost for a showmobile for St. Leo the Great Festival held on September 5, 2004, San Juan Capistrano Church Festival held on October 16,, 2004 and the St, Lawrence Catholic Church Festival held on May 7, 2005;
- \$1,300.00 to the United States Military Veterans Parade Association to offset the cost for barricade expenses in connection with its annual parade held on November 6, 2004;
- \$2,500.00 to the American Opportunity for Housing, Inc. to be used as capital for the sole purpose of a child care facility at the Reserve at Pecan Valley Apartment Complex; and

WHEREAS, a sufficient balance exists in the District 3 One-Time Project Budget Corpus Christi Sewer Lateral Project fund to support these requests, which City Council desires to grant;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The request of Councilman Ron Segovia, City Councilman of District 3, for funds of \$9,050.00 to be transferred from the District 3 One Time Projects Old Corpus Christi Sewer Lateral Fund for fiscal year 2004-2005 to the Parks and Recreation Department, United States Military Veterans Parade Association and the American Opportunity for Housing, Inc. is hereby approved and authorized. A copy of Councilman Segovia's request is set out in Attachment 1.

SECTION 2. The Interim City Manager or a designee is hereby authorized for a period of sixty (60) days from the effective date of this Ordinance, to execute an agreement between the United States Military Veterans Parade Association in the amount of \$1,300.00 to offset the cost for barricade expenses in connection with its annual parade held on November 6, 2004 and \$2,500.00 to the American Opportunity for Housing, Inc. for the sole purpose of a child care facility at the Reserve at Pecan Valley Apartment Complex.

SECTION 3. These Agreements will set out the terms and conditions for receiving and using public funds. A substantially final copy of the Agreements is attached to this ordinance as Attachments II and III and will be replaced with fully executed agreements upon final execution by the parties.

SECTION 4. Funds in the amount of \$3,000.00 are authorized to be transferred from Cost Center 7002030007, General Ledger 5201040, entitled "Fees to Professional Contractors", Fund 11001000, entitled "General Fund" to Internal Order 255000000000, General Ledger 4410130, entitled "Solid Waste Services Out of Cycle-Brush", Fund 55001000, entitled "Solid Waste Operating Fund".

SECTION 5. Funds in the amount of \$2,250.00 are authorized to be transferred from Cost Center 7002030007, General Ledger 5201040, entitled "Fees to Professional Contractors", Fund 11001000, entitled "General Fund" to Internal Order 2260000000051, General Ledger 4407907, entitled "Rental-Stages and Equipment", Fund 11001000, entitled "General Fund".

SECTION 6. Funds in the amount of \$1,300.00 are authorized to be encumbered in Cost Center 7002030007, General Ledger 5201040, entitled "Fees to Professional Contractors," Fund 11001000, entitled "General Fund" and made payable to United States Military Veterans Parade Association.

SECTION 7. Funds in the amount of \$2,500.00 are authorized to be encumbered in Cost Center 7002030007, General Ledger 5201040, entitled "Fees to Professional Contractors", Fund 11001000, entitled "General Fund" and made payable to American Opportunity for Housing.

SECTION 8. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.
