

AN ORDINANCE 100976

**ACCEPTING THE BID SUBMITTED BY THE STATE OF TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION RESOURCES TO PROVIDE WEB DEVELOPER SERVICES FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$98,899.20, FROM THE URBAN AREAS SECURITY INITIATIVES GRANT FUND.**

**WHEREAS**, a bid was submitted by the State of Texas Department of Information Resources to provide the Fire Department with web developer services for a total cost of \$98,899.20; and

**WHEREAS**, this contract will provide web developer services to convert a preplan database system to a web enabled platform; and

**WHEREAS**, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the State of Texas Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Resolution No. 91-39-53 on September 12, 1991, and the Interlocal Cooperation Contract with the Texas Department of Information Resources passed by Ordinance No. 99520 on August 5, 2004;  
**NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The bid of the Texas Department of Information Resources in the amount of \$98,899.20 to provide the Fire Department with web developer services is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. A copy of the bid tabulation sheet and work order are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.


**SECTION 2.** Funding in the amount of \$98,899.20 is approved for purchase of Web developer services for the City of San Antonio Fire Department as appropriated in existing SAP Fund 26065000, entitled "Urban Area Security Initiatives Grant".

**SECTION 3.** The amount of \$98,899.20 will be encumbered and made payable to the Department of Information Resources from SAP Fund 26065000, Internal Order No. 120000000021, GL Account No. 5202020 entitled "Contractual Services".

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or the Interim City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers and Internal orders as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2005.


