

AN ORDINANCE 100972

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR THE SBC CENTER IN CONNECTION WITH THE JUNETEENTH PARADE SPONSORED BY THE JUNETEENTH COALITION TO BE HELD FROM 8:30 A.M. TO NOON ON SATURDAY, JUNE 18, 2005.

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WHEREAS, the Juneteenth Coalition has requested the approval of a parade permit to hold its "Juneteenth Parade" on Saturday, June 18, 2005 from 8:30 a.m. until 12:00 noon, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Juneteenth Coalition has requested closure of certain streets near the SBC Center, as listed in the above referenced permit; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by the Juneteenth Coalition to hold the "Juneteenth Parade" on Saturday, June 18, 2005 from 8:30 a.m. until 12:00 noon, is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity. City staff is authorized to close City of San Antonio streets listed in the parade permit route, and to take reasonable and necessary steps to implement this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Funds in the amount of \$25.00 are authorized to be deposited in Fund 11001000 entitled "General Fund", Internal Order Number 223000000082, entitled "TRFC ENG- DES/REV", General Ledger 4408100 entitled "Street-Barricade Fees" when received.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Juneteenth Coalition shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.


SECTION 5. Juneteenth Coalition shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on June 12, 2005.
