

AN ORDINANCE **100971**

APPROVING THE TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE OF WOODWARD PLACE BETWEEN DWYER AVENUE AND THE DEAD END FROM 10:00 A.M. SATURDAY, JUNE 18, 2005 TO 2:00 A.M. SUNDAY, JUNE 19, 2005 IN ORDER TO HOLD A WEDDING RECEPTION AT THE INN ON THE RIVER.

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The street closure of Woodward Place between Dwyer Avenue and the Dead End (122 Woodward Place to 129 Woodward Place) as requested by **Clare E. Parry**, to hold a wedding reception at the Inn on the River beginning on Saturday, June 18, 2005 at 10:00 a. m., until Sunday, June 19, 2005, at 2:00 a. m., is hereby authorized. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The Interim City Manager or his designee, is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the government.

SECTION 3. **Clare E. Parry** shall be responsible for the following:

- a) fulfilling all insurance requirements, paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges;
- b) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments;
- c) evidencing the street closure to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic; and
- d) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 4. **Clare E. Parry** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street rights of way.

SECTION 5. Funds in the amount of \$75.00 are authorized to be deposited in Fund 11001000 entitled "General Fund", Internal Order Number 223000000082, entitled "TRFC ENG- DES/REV", General Ledger 4408100 entitled "Street-Barricade Fees" when received.

SECTION 6. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be effective on June 12, 2005.


