

AN ORDINANCE 100279

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER (UTHSC) AT SAN ANTONIO IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,660.00 FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PROJECT STAY (SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT ACCESS FOR YOUTH) FOR THE PERIOD OF SEPTEMBER 30, 2004 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 29, 2005; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT AND ADOPTING A BUDGET IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

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WHEREAS, the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio, (UTHSC) Department of Pediatrics, Division of Community Pediatrics in collaboration with the City of San Antonio, Department of Community Initiatives submitted a proposal to the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to implement a Substance Abuse Reentry Grant program to support the reentry needs of adjudicated youth; and

WHEREAS, HHS awarded the UTHSC, Department of Pediatrics, Division of Community Pediatrics a Substance Abuse Reentry Grant for the support of Project STAY (Substance Abuse Treatment Access for Youth); and

WHEREAS, the UTHSC, Department of Pediatrics, Division of Community Pediatrics desires to enter into a contract with the City of San Antonio, Department of Community Initiatives, for the provision of job readiness/life skills training and General Education and Development (GED) referral services for Project STAY participants during the contract period of September 30, 2004 through September 29, 2005; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Interim City Manager or in his stead, either an Assistant City Manager, an Assistant to the City Manager or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to accept an award of \$22,660.00 from the University of Texas Health Science Center (UTHSC) at San Antonio, Department of Pediatrics, Division of Community Pediatrics for the purpose of providing job readiness/life skills and General Education and Development (GED) referral services in support of Project STAY (Substance Abuse Treatment Access for Youth) participants for the period of September 30, 2004 through September 29, 2005. The Interim City Manager or in his stead, either an Assistant City Manager, an Assistant to the City Manager or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to execute a contract with the UTHSC in connection therewith. A copy of said contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. Internal Order No. 138000000302, entitled "Youth Opportunity Project STAY" is designated for use in accounting for said funds and the sum of \$22,660.00 is appropriated in said fund. The budget, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment II, is adopted.



The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager, an Assistant City Manager or an Assistant to the City Manager, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP internal orders and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective on and after January 23, 2005.
