AN ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000.00 FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S SPEED SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM, WHICH WILL CONTINUE TO FUND AN OVERTIME PROGRAM FOR SPEED ENFORCEMENT FOR THE GRANT PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2005, TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2006; AUTHORIZING AN IN-KIND MATCH OF \$39,342.00 AND A CASH MATCH OF \$16,215.00.**

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has grant funds available in the amount of \$500,000.00 to fund the fifth year of the TxDOT Speed Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP); and

**WHEREAS**, the grant funds, if awarded, will continue to fund an overtime program for speed enforcement for the grant period of October 1, 2005 to September 30, 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, an award of these grant funds would require an in-kind matching contribution of \$39,342.00 and a cash match of \$16,215.00 from the Police Department's General Fund; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to submit a grant application in the amount of \$500,000.00 to the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) speed Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP), which, if awarded, will continue to fund an overtime program for speed enforcement. An in-kind matching contribution of \$39,342.00 and a cash match of \$16,215.00 from the Police Department's General Fund are hereby authorized in connection with the submission of the grant application.

**SECTION 2.** Funding will be accomplished by way of a subsequent Ordinance should the grant funds be awarded.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
