

AN ORDINANCE 100343

ACKNOWLEDGING CONTRACT MODIFICATIONS WITH ALAMO WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT, INC. AWARDED ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$870,000.00 FOR DIRECT CHILD CARE AND OPERATIONS EXPENDITURES WITHIN THE ALAMO AREA CHILD CARE DELIVERY SYSTEM (CCDS) PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2004 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2004; AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF SAID FUNDS; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE DELEGATE AGENCY CONTRACT WITH ALAMO AREA DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION PROVIDING ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,000.00 FOR THE PROVISION OF CHILDCARE SERVICES FOR THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2004 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2005; APPROVING A REVISED FY 2004-2005 CCDS PROGRAM BUDGET; AND APPROVING A REVISED PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT.

**WHEREAS**, on August 28, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 98090, the City Council authorized the operation of the Alamo Area Child Care Delivery System (CCDS) program for the period September 1, 2003 to August 31, 2005 with funds from the Texas Workforce Commission awarded and managed through Alamo Workforce Development, Inc. (AWD); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Antonio, through its Child Care Delivery System Division of the Department of Community Initiatives serves as administrator for the CCDS Program for the Alamo Workforce Development Area; and

**WHEREAS**, AWD has reviewed their current child care appropriations to identify any remaining funds for reallocation prior to their expiration; and

**WHEREAS**, AWD has issued contract modifications providing additional funding in the amount of \$870,000.00 for direct child care and operations expenditures of the CCDS; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to amend its delegate agency contract with the Alamo Area Development Corporation (AADC) to provide funds in the amount of \$70,000.00 for the provision of child care services for the period of October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary to acknowledge contract modifications in connection with the CCDS program, to authorize the acceptance of additional funds in the amount of \$870,000.00, to authorize the execution of a contract amendment in the amount of \$70,000.00 to AADC, to approve a revised FY 2005 CCDS program budget and to approve a revised personnel complement; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Unilateral Modifications Nos. 3 and 3.1 from the Alamo Workforce Development, Inc. which award additional funds in the amount of \$870,000.00 for direct child care and operations expenditures within the Alamo Area Child Care Delivery System (CCDS) Program for the period of October 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004 are acknowledged. Copies of said modifications are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I and II.

**SECTION 2.** The Interim City Manager, or his designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to accept additional funds in the amount of \$870,000.00 for the provision of Direct Childcare and Operations expenditures in connection with the CCDS Program for the period of October 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004.

**SECTION 3.** The Interim City Manager or his designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to execute an amendment to the Delegate Agency Contract with the Alamo Area Development Corporation providing additional funds in the amount of \$70,000.00 for the provision of childcare services for the period of October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005. A copy of said amendment, in substantially final form, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment III.

**SECTION 4.** A revised budget for the FY 2004-2005 the CCDS program, Fund Center 381506000, Internal Order No. 138000000272, entitled "Child Care Delivery System Program 2004-2005", attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment IV, is approved.

**SECTION 5.** The personnel complement, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment V, is approved.



The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager, an Assistant City Manager, or an Assistant to the City Manager, may correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP internal orders, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.


**SECTION 7.** This ordinance shall become effective on and after February 6, 2005.
