AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE BID FROM INTERSPIRO, INC. TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO WITH SELF CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS FOR A TOTAL OF \$207,500.70, WHICH WILL BE OBLIGATED FROM AIRPORT FUNDS, PROCEEDS FROM SALES OF FIRE STATION BUILDINGS AND HOMELAND SECURITY FUNDS.

WHEREAS, a bid was submitted by Interspiro, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with self contained breathing apparatus equipment ("SCBA") for an original cost of \$1,882,182.00, which was accepted by Ordinance No. 100448 on February 17, 2005; and

WHEREAS, this contract will allow the City to acquire additional equipment and components necessary to maintain the self contained breathing apparatus, an air compressor, a containment fill station, and storage bottle systems, some replacement self contained breathing apparatus, air packs, gas masks, carbon fiber cylinders and hard carrying cases to hold the equipment for an additional total cost of \$207,500.70; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Houston/Galveston Area Council of Governments ("HGACOG") Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio on October 10, 1996 through Resolution No. 96-41-48, **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid of Interspiro, Inc. to provide additional self contained breathing apparatus equipment for a total cost of \$207,500.70, is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. A copy of the bid tabulation sheet and HGACOG contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$207,500.70 is approved for the purchase of the self contained breathing apparatus equipment and components for the City of San Antonio Fire Department.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$207,500.70 will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase order and made payable to Interspiro, Inc. from the following funds:

- a) SAP Fund 510001000, Cost Center 330209001, GL Account 5304050 in the amount of \$48,371.73;
- b) SAP Fund 26065000, Internal Order 123000000327, GL Account 5304050 in the amount of \$69,787.77;
- c) SAP Fund 26065000, Internal Order 120000000020, GL Account 5304050 in the amount of \$19,033.03;

- d) SAP Fund 45099000, WBS Element 20-00100-05-05, GL Account 5701060 in the amount of \$30,083.52;
- e) SAP Fund 26065000, Internal Order 120000000018, GL Account 5304050 in the amount of \$19,033.03; and
- f) SAP Fund 26065000, Internal Order 120000000019, GL Account 5304050 in the amount of \$21,191.62.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or his designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers and Internal Orders as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect October 9, 2005.




