

AN ORDINANCE **101473**

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM THE TEXAS STATE LIBRARY AND ARCHIVES COMMISSION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$716,349.00 WHICH WILL BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PUBLIC LIBRARY DEVELOPMENT IN THE ALAMO AREA LIBRARY SYSTEM FOR THE GRANT PERIOD SEPTEMBER 1, 2005 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2006; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A GRANT CONTRACT.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio is a Major Resource Center for the Alamo Area Library System, providing services to Bexar county and 20 other contiguous counties; and

WHEREAS, since 1972, the City has provided this service and has accepted federal grant funds through the Texas State Library and Archives in support of this service; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for these grant funds pursuant to Ordinance No.101111, which was passed and approved on July 7, 2005; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary for the City Council to authorize the acceptance of this grant from the Texas State Library and Archives Commission and the execution of related documents and contracts; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept the Library System Operation Grant from the Texas State Library and Archives Commission in the amount of \$716,349.00 for use in providing a variety of library services to the Alamo Area Library System member libraries. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby further authorized to execute the Library System Operation Grant contract, affixed hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I, as well as any and all other necessary contracts or documents to effectuate that acceptance.

SECTION 2. Fund 26-018000, Internal Order No. 104000000025, entitled "Library System Services" has been established in SAP for the above said grant, and the budget affixed hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment II is approved.

SECTION 3. The sum of \$716,349.00 in funding is approved and hereby appropriated in said Internal Order as set out in the Attachment II.


SECTION 4. The personnel complement set out in Attachment II is hereby authorized and approved.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on and after October 9, 2005.
