

AN ORDINANCE 100384

AUTHORIZING \$22,300.00 FROM THE COUNCIL DISTRICT 4 NEIGHBORHOOD ACCESS AND MOBILITY FUND FOR THE MODIFICATION OF LEFT-TURN SIGNAL PHASES ON THE EAST-WEST APPROACHES OF SOUTHCROSS AT ZARZAMORA, THE NORTH-SOUTH APPROACHES OF BARLITE AT S.W. MILITARY DRIVE, THE EAST-WEST APPROACHES OF SOUTHCROSS AT COMMERCIAL; CHANGING OF THE LEFT-TURN SIGNAL PHASE FROM THE EAST-WEST APPROACHES OF ANSLEY AT ZARZAMORA TO THE NORTH-SOUTH APPROACHES OF ZARZAMORA AT ANSLEY; AND INSTALLATION OF SCHOOL ZONE FLASHING BEACONS ON RAY ELLISON BLVD. FROM OLD VALLEY HI DRIVE TO MEDINA BASE ROAD AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN RICHARD PEREZ, DISTRICT 4.

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the City of San Antonio to create a safer community; and

WHEREAS, additional flashing beacons for school zones and modifications of the phasing of certain existing traffic control devices will aid in achieving that goal; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Modification of left-turn signal phases on the East-West approaches of Southcross at Zarzamora, the North-South approaches of Barlite at S.W. Military Drive, and the East-West approaches of Southcross at Commercial are hereby authorized in a manner to achieve greater public safety through traffic calming.

SECTION 2. The left-turn signal phase from the East-West approaches of Ansley at Zarzamora is hereby authorized to be changed to the North-South approaches of Zarzamora at Ansley.

SECTION 3. Installation of school zone flashing beacons on Ray Ellison Blvd. from Old Valley Hi Drive to Medina Base Road is hereby authorized.

SECTION 4. The amount of \$22,300.00 from the Council District 4 Neighborhood Access and Mobility Fund is authorized for use for the modifications and installations authorized by this ordinance.

SECTION 5. The amount of \$22,300 is appropriated in Fund 29-05000, Street Improvements, in SAP general ledger account 5301010, cost center 2303050013, entitled NAMP CD4 Traffic Calming Devices.

SECTION 6. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, the Interim City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be effective on February 13, 2005.


