

AN ORDINANCE 100204

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT AND CERTAIN AMENDMENTS THERETO, WITH THE SAN ANTONIO NEIGHBORHOOD ASSISTANCE CORPORATION DBA NEIGHBORHOOD RESOURCE CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,000.00 FOR THE PROVISION OF HUMAN AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DURING THE PERIOD DECEMBER 26, 2004 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2005; AND AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION AND EXPENDITURE OF HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00 FROM THE MAYOR'S OFFICE; \$1,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 2; \$1,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 3; \$2,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 5; \$3,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 7; \$2,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 8; \$1,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 9 AND \$5,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 10 FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$20,000.00 FOR THE PROVISION OF HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES.

**WHEREAS**, the Fiscal Year (FY) 2005 Adopted Budget passed and approved through Ordinance No. 99725 on September 16, 2004 established the City Council Human Development Services (HDSF) Fund to support human development service-related purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Antonio Neighborhood Assistance Corporation DBA Neighborhood Resource Center is a non profit advocacy and resource center for community members to strengthen neighborhood involvement and the Neighborhood Resource Center has offered to provide educational and networking opportunities for increased community education and involvement and to conduct the 16<sup>th</sup> annual neighborhood conference; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 12, 2004, Mayor Garza circulated a memorandum requesting to place as a City Council agenda item the authorization to reallocate \$5,000.00 of the Mayor's HDSF to the Neighborhood Resource Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Mayor Garza also requested each Councilmember to consider contributing HDSF to the Neighborhood Resource Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and various Councilmembers desire to contribute HDSF totalling \$20,000.00 for the support of the Neighborhood Resource Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the public purpose for said expenditure is to provide education and training for the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Neighborhood Resource Center will provide human development related services in the priority areas of youth development and community recreation;  
**NOWTHEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The Interim City Manager, or an Assistant City Manager, or an Assistant to the City Manager, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to execute a contract with the San Antonio Neighborhood Assistance Corporation dba Neighborhood Resource Center in the amount of \$20,000.00 for multiple workshops and support services in preparation for the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Neighborhood Conference. The Interim City Manager, or in his stead, an Assistant City Manager or an Assistant to the City Manager or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to negotiate and execute said contract. If a contract, as first reviewed and approved by the City Attorney, is not signed by both parties within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this ordinance, it becomes null and void, and any further signed documents must be considered by the City Council.

**SECTION 2.** The amount of \$20,000.00 is authorized for encumbrance in Fund 11-001000 entitled "General Fund", as follows:

Said total amount is authorized payable to the Neighborhood Resource Center.


**SECTION 3.** The Interim City Manager, or in his stead, an Assistant City Manager, or an Assistant to the City Manager, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to execute contract amendments to the contract described in this ordinance when additional monies increase funding to said contract in an amount not exceeding twenty-five percent (25%) of the total contract or \$25,000.00, whichever is the lesser amount, provided the cumulative total of all amendments increasing contract funding during the term of the contract shall not exceed the foregoing amount.


**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager, an Assistant City Manager or an Assistant to the City Manager, may correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP internal orders and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall become effective on and after December 26, 2004.
