

AN ORDINANCE 100391

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA IN CONNECTION WITH THE ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADE BE HELD FROM 12:00 P.M. UNTIL 4:00 P.M. SATURDAY, MARCH 12, 2005.

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the requested parade permit to the St. Patrick's Day Commission to hold the "St. Patrick's Day Parade" on Saturday, March 12, 2005 from 12:00 noon until 4:00 p.m. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. In order to hold the "St. Patrick's Day Parade" on Saturday, March 12, 2005, the following streets listed below are hereby authorized to be closed to vehicular traffic:

Assemble: Ave E between Third and Brooklyn.

Parade Route: South on Avenue E to Houston Street,
West on Houston to Alamo
South on Alamo to Nueva
West on Nueva to Presa

Disband: Presa between Market and Nueva in La Villita

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

SECTION 4. The St. Patrick's Day Commission shall be responsible for the following:

- a) all insurance requirements,
- b) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges,
- c) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works

- and/or Police Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and
- d) cleaning the area after the event is held.

SECTION 5. Funds in the amount of \$25.00 are authorized to be deposited in Order Number 223000000082, General Ledger 4408100 entitled "Street – Barricade Fees", Fund 11001000 entitled "General Fund" when received.

SECTION 6. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance


SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be effective on February 20, 2005.
