

AN ORDINANCE 100452

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT AND CERTAIN AMENDMENTS THERETO, WITH CONGREGATION BETH-EL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$28,000.00 FOR THE CONGREGATION BETH-EL KIMMELMAN CHILDCARE SCHOLARSHIP GRANT PROGRAM DURING THE PERIOD FEBRUARY 17, 2005 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2005; AND AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION AND EXPENDITURE OF HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000.00 FROM THE MAYOR'S OFFICE, \$20,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 1, \$3,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 3, \$1,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 4, \$1,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 9, AND \$2,000.00 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 10 FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$28,000.00 FOR THE CONGREGATION BETH-EL KIMMELMAN CHILDCARE SCHOLARSHIP GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year (FY) 2005 Adopted Budget passed and approved through Ordinance No. 99725 on September 16, 2004 established the City Council Human Development Services (HDSF) Fund to support human development service-related purposes; and

WHEREAS, Congregation Beth-El is a non-profit organization operating the Kimmelman Childcare Scholarship Grant Program providing funding for direct childcare of low to moderate income parents who wish to return to school or seek employment opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and various Councilmembers desire to contribute HDSF totalling \$28,000.00 for the support of the Congregation Beth-El Kimmelman Childcare Scholarship Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the public purpose for said expenditure is to promote family, social and economic stability; and

WHEREAS, direct child care assistance is an eligible project under the Family Strengthening Initiatives of the HDSF; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to execute a contract with Congregation Beth-El in the amount of \$28,000.00 for the Congregation Beth-El Kimmelman Childcare Scholarship Grant Program during the period February 17, 2005 through September 30, 2005. A copy of said contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$28,000.00 is authorized to be encumbered in Fund 11001000 entitled "General Fund", General Ledger 5201040 entitled "Fees to Professional Contractors" as follows:

These funds are authorized to be payable to Congregation Beth-El.

SECTION 3. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to execute contract amendments to the contract described in this ordinance when additional monies increase funding to said contract in an amount not exceeding twenty-five percent (25%) of the total contract or \$25,000.00, whichever is the lesser amount, provided the cumulative total of all amendments increasing contract funding during the term of the contract shall not exceed the foregoing amount.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or the Interim City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective on and after February 27, 2005.


