AN ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR DOWNTOWN IN CONNECTION WITH THE GRAND MASTER'S VISIT TO THE ALAMO TO BE HELD FROM 9:30 A.M. UNTIL 11:00 A.M. SATURDAY, MARCH 5, 2005.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by the **Masonic Grand Lodge of Texas** to hold its "Grand Master's Visit to the Alamo" on Saturday, March 5, 2004 from 9:30 a.m. until 11:00 a.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

**Route**

Assembling at Scottish Rite Temple on 308 Avenue E,  
South on Avenue E to Houston,  
West on Houston to Alamo,  
South on Alamo, disbanding at The Alamo.

SECTION 3. **Masonic Grand Lodge of Texas** shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 4. **Masonic Grand Lodge of Texas** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 5. Funds in the amount of \$25.00 are authorized to be deposited in Fund 11001000, entitled "General Fund", Order Number 223000000082, General Ledger 4408100 entitled "Streets and Barricade Fees".

SECTION 6. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be effective on February 27, 2005.
