

AN ORDINANCE **100415**

ACCEPTING THE BID SUBMITTED BY BABY JACK II AUTOMOTIVE LTD., D/B/A CALDWELL COUNTRY CHEVROLET, TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT SWAT UNIT WITH A REPLACEMENT CUT-A-WAY CAB AND CHASSIS WITH VAN BODY FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$48,755.00 FROM THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT BLOCK GRANT.

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WHEREAS, a bid was submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with one cut-a-way cab and chassis with van body; and

WHEREAS, the bid was submitted by Baby Jack II Automotive Ltd., Caldwell Country Chevrolet for a total cost of \$48,755.00; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid submitted by Baby Jack II Automotive Ltd., Caldwell Country Chevrolet to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with one cut-a-way cab and chassis with van body for a total cost of \$48,755.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the successful bidder's completion of all conditions precedent to award or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. Attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A are the bid and bid tabulation sheet.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$48,755.00 is approved for purchase of a cut-a-way cab and chassis with van body for the SWAT Unit of the Police Department as appropriated in existing SAP Fund 26028000, entitled "2004-2005 Local Law Enforcement Block Grant".

SECTION 3. The amount of \$48,755.00 is encumbered and payable to Baby Jack II Automotive Ltd. from SAP Fund 26028000, Internal Order No. 117000000057, SAP GL Account no. 5501050 entitled "Machinery and Equipment-Auto" for the above said vehicle.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or the Interim City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers and Internal orders as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect February 27th, 2005.
