

AN ORDINANCE 100548

AMENDING THE SOUTHSIDE INITIATIVE COMMUNITY PLAN, A COMPONENT OF THE MASTER PLAN OF THE CITY, BY CHANGING THE TITLE OF THE SOUTHSIDE INITIATIVE COMMUNITY PLAN FROM "SOUTHSIDE INITIATIVE COMMUNITY PLAN" TO "CITY SOUTH COMMUNITY PLAN".

WHEREAS, the Southside Initiative Community Plan was adopted on June 26, 2003 by City Council as a component of the City Master Plan adopted May 29, 1997; and

WHEREAS, the on-going construction of the Toyota Motor Company truck production facility and the potential location of a Texas A&M University campus have positioned the planning area for future growth and development consistent with the goals of the plan, including supporting sustainable development, protecting and strengthening the area's economic, social, and environmental resources, and supporting neighborhood-based housing and community needs; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Ed Garza has deemed the Southside Initiative as no longer a project or an initiative, but rather a designated destination with its own name, personality, and future; and

WHEREAS, a press conference and public gathering was held on October 13, 2004 by Mayor Ed Garza's office announcing the name change and new logo design; **NOW THEREFORE;**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The title of the "Southside Initiative Community Plan" is hereby changed from "Southside Initiative Community Plan" to "City South Community Plan."

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect on March 20, 2005.
