AN ORDINANCE 100536

AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR THE CULTURAL COLLABORATIVE: A COMMUNITY PLAN FOR SAN ANTONIO'S CREATIVE ECONOMY WITH JERRY ALLEN & ASSOCIATES TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SERVICES FOR THE CULTURAL COLLABORATIVE, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$17,500.00, INCLUSIVE OF ALL EXPENSES AND FEES; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2004, City Council approved ordinance No. 98794 authorizing the City Manager to execute a Professional Services Agreement (the "Agreement") with Jerry Allen & Associates (the "Consultant"), in the amount of \$150,000.00, for professional cultural planning services for The Cultural Collaborative: A Community Plan for San Antonio's Creative Economy ("TCC"); and

WHEREAS, in order to complete the TCC planning process, it is necessary for the Consultant to make additional site visits to San Antonio to conduct four (4) community presentations and meetings, provide research input and consultation for the Economic Impact Study of San Antonio's Creative Industry, and provide input on developing the TCC marketing and public relations tool; and

WHEREAS, as these additional services are essential to the completion of the TCC planning process, City staff recommends that City Council authorize this First Amendment to the Agreement for The Cultural Collaborative: A Community Plan for San Antonio's Creative Economy; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The terms and conditions of the First Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement for The Cultural Collaborative: A Community Plan for San Antonio's Creative Economy are hereby authorized and approved.

SECTION 2. The Interim City Manager or his designee is authorized, for a sixty (60)-day period following the effective date of this Ordinance, to execute the First Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement for The Cultural Collaborative: A Community Plan for San Antonio's Creative Economy. A copy of said First Amendment, previously executed by Jerry Allen & Associates, is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment I.

SECTION 3. Funds were appropriated in the Fiscal Year 2005 budget process, and funds will be encumbered in Cost Center 2801010004, General Ledger 5201040 entitled, "Fees to Professional Contractors", in Fund 29006000, entitled "Hotel Motel Tax Fund", in the amount of \$17,500.00. Payment is authorized to Jerry Allen & Associates in the amount not to exceed \$17,500.00.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth day after passage hereof.




