

AN ORDINANCE

**RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$114,449.00 TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, FOR THE FOURTH YEAR OF THE PROJECT EDUCATE, ASSESS, SERVE AND EMPOWER OF THE VICTIMS ADVOCACY SECTION OF THE SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT.**

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**WHEREAS**, the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) has submitted a grant application in the amount of \$114,449.00 to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division (CJD), for the fourth year of the Project Educate, Assess, Serve and Empower (EASE) of the Victims Advocacy Section of the SAPD; and

**WHEREAS**, said project assists in providing police services to victims of violent crime who are deaf and funds professional translation services and community outreach and education programs for the deaf; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant application certification number for said grant application is 16211-04; and

**WHEREAS**, should the grant application be approved by the CJD and should the grant be accepted by the San Antonio City Council, an in-kind matching contribution of \$22,890.00 in employee and volunteer hours will be provided; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The actions of the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) in submitting a grant application in the amount of \$114,449.00 to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division (CJD), for the fourth year of the Project Educate, Assess, Serve and Empower (EASE) of the Victims Advocacy Section of the SAPD are hereby ratified. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute any and all documentation necessary to effect said submission.

**SECTION 2.** Assistant City Manager Christopher J. Brady is hereby designated as the authorized grant official for said grant application, and he is hereby authorized to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant upon proper approval of the San Antonio City Council.

**SECTION 3.** In the event of loss or misuse of the CJD grant funds, said funds will be returned to the CJD in full.


**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
