

AN ORDINANCE **100571**

APPROVING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KENTUCKY AVENUE BETWEEN NORTH ELMENDORF AND NORTH ZARZAMORA FROM 8:00 A.M. ON SATURDAY, APRIL 9, 2005 UNTIL 11:30 P.M. ON SUNDAY, APRIL 10, 2005 FOR LITTLE FLOWER CHURCH'S ANNUAL SCHOOL FESTIVAL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The request by the **Little Flower Church** to hold the "Annual Little Flower Church Festival" from 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 9, 2005, until 11:30 p.m. on Sunday, April 10, 2005, is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of Kentucky Avenue between North Elmendorf and North Zarzamora, in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event.

SECTION 3. Funds in the amount of \$75.00 are authorized to be deposited in Order Number 223000000082, General Ledger 4408100, entitled "Streets and Barricade Fees", Fund 11001000, entitled "General Fund" when received.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance


SECTION 5. **Little Flower Church** shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 6. **Little Flower Church** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall become effective on April 3, 2005.
