

AN ORDINANCE 100560

ACCEPTING THE SINGLE SOURCE OFFER SUBMITTED BY FATS, INC. TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH A FIREARMS TRAINING SIMULATOR SYSTEM FOR A TOTAL OF COST OF \$41,600.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER STANDARD AND EDUCATION FUND.

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WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by FATS, Inc., a sole source supplier, to provide the City of San Antonio ("City") Police Department with a firearms training simulator system for a total cost of \$41,600.00; and

WHEREAS, the firearms training simulator system provides police officers with judgmental training and accuracy training used with pistols and rifles; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(7)(A) which provides for any items that are available only from a sole source of supply; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer submitted by FATS, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with a firearms training simulator system for a total cost of \$41,600.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. The Interim City Manager, the Director of Purchasing & General Services, and the Chief of Police, or any of their designees are hereby authorized to execute the contract, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. Funds will be encumbered in Cost Center 1791010001, General Ledger 5709060 entitled, "CO>5K-M&E", in Fund 29616002 entitled, "Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education" when a purchase order in the amount of \$41,600.00 is issued and made payable to Fats, Inc.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect April 3, 2005.
