

AN ORDINANCE 100615

**ACCEPTING THE LOW, RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED BY GOLF CARS, ETC. TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC WORKS AND PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENTS WITH SIX (6) REPLACEMENT UTILITY VEHICLES FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$79,648.08.**

**WHEREAS**, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Public Works and Parks & Recreation Departments with six four-wheel automatic utility vehicles for use at Brackenridge Park and for parking enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, the bid submitted by Jones Equipment & Turf, Inc. failed to meet the City specifications; and

**WHEREAS**, Golf Cars, Etc. was the low responsive bidder for a total contract cost of \$79,648.08; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The low, responsive bid of Golf Cars, Etc. to provide the City of San Antonio Public Works and Parks & Recreation Departments with six four-wheel automatic utility vehicles for a total cost of \$79,648.08 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the deposit by the successful bidder of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. The bid and bid tabulation sheet are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

**SECTION 2.** It has been found and declared that the low bid of Jones Equipment & Turf, Inc. failed to meet the City's specifications.

**SECTION 3.** The amount of \$79,648.08 is authorized to be encumbered in Fund 72-001000, Equipment Renewal And Replacement Fund, in G/L Account 5501050, entitled Capital Outlay-Over \$5,000, in Fund Center 1503200000, Cost Center 1503200001, and is authorized to be made payable to Golf Cars Etc., when the purchase order is issued.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director, may subject to concurrence by

the Interim City Manager or his designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall take effect April 10, 2005.


