

AN ORDINANCE 100614

ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL SUBMITTED BY PHILPOTT MOTORS, LTD. UTILIZING THE TEXAS BUYBOARD CONTRACT, TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT WITH ONE (1) SPORT UTILITY VEHICLE FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$30,249.00, FROM URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVES GRANT FUNDS.

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WHEREAS, a proposal was submitted by Philpott Motors, Ltd. to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with one (1) sport utility vehicle for a total cost of \$30,249.00; and

WHEREAS, a four-wheel drive SUV with sufficient capacity and ground clearance for off-road travel, as well as towing capacity is required for the City Initial Support Strike Team to respond to large-scale emergency incidents for the citizens of San Antonio, Bexar and Comal counties as well as the entire region pursuant to the Regional Mutual Aid Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the sport utility vehicle will be provided by Philpott Motors, Ltd., utilizing a contract procured by the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative ("TLGPC"); and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Interlocal Participation Agreement with the TLGPC approved by ordinance 97097 passed and approved on January 30, 2003, **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The proposal of Philpott Motors, Ltd., in the amount of \$30,249.00 to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with one (1) sport utility vehicle is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. A copy of the bid tabulation sheet and proposal are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$30,249.00 is approved for purchase of one sport utility vehicle for the City of San Antonio Fire Department as appropriated in an existing SAP Fund No. 26065000, entitled "Urban Area Security Initiatives Grant".

SECTION 3. The amount of \$30,249.00 will be encumbered and made payable to Philpott Motors, Ltd. utilizing Texas BuyBoard, upon issuance of a purchase order, from SAP Fund 26065000, Internal Order No. 120000000022, SAP GL Account no. 5501050 entitled "Machinery and Equipment-Automotive" for the above said vehicle.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to

concurrence by the Interim City Manager or the Interim City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers and Internal orders as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect April 10, 2005.

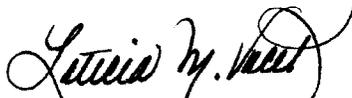
