

AN ORDINANCE 101161

**ACCEPTING THE LOW, RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED BY CONSOLIDATED TRAFFIC CONTROLS, UTILIZING THE HOUSTON GALVESTON AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (HGAC) CONTRACT, TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT WITH TRAFFIC SIGNAL PREEMPTION EQUIPMENT FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$169,280.53, FROM ADVANCED TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT FUNDS.**

**WHEREAS**, a bid was submitted by Consolidated Traffic Controls to provide the City of San Antonio Public Works Department with traffic signal preemption equipment for a total cost of \$169,280.53; and

**WHEREAS**, this contract will provide traffic signal preemption devices for installation at various downtown intersections so that emergency vehicles serving the downtown area will be provided intersection right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Houston/Galveston Area Council of Governments Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio on October 10, 1996 through Resolution No. 96-41-48, **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The bid of Consolidated Traffic Controls in the amount of \$169,280.53 to provide the City of San Antonio Public Works Department with traffic signal preemption equipment is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. A copy of the bid tabulation sheet and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

**SECTION 2.** Funds in the amount of \$169,280.53 for this ordinance are approved in the FY 2004-2005 budget in Fund 2908400 GL 5204080 Cost Center 8002160001. The funds will be encumbered upon the issuance of a purchase order made payable to Consolidated Traffic Controls in the amount of \$169,280.53.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance for the City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to

specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect August 21, 2005.




