

AN ORDINANCE **101248**

**AUTHORIZING ADJUSTMENTS TO THE DISTRICT 5 ONE-TIME PROJECTS BUDGET BY REDUCING FUNDS SET ASIDE IN FY 2000 FOR THE INMAN CHRISTIAN CENTER CORRIDOR REVITALIZATION FROM \$48,321.32 TO \$23,783.87; CONTRIBUTING 20,391.00 TO THE AMISTAD PARK PROJECT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND ONE YEAR MAINTENANCE OF A PORTABLE TOILET SCREEN ENCLOSURE AND ADA PATH OF TRAVEL; \$1,146.45 TO VFW POST 4700 TO HELP OFFSET THE COST OF BUILDING A FENCE FOR THEIR BASEBALL FIELD; AND \$3,000.00 TO ST. PAUL LUTHERAN CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER TO HELP OFFSET THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THEIR DIRECT CHILDCARE; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMEMBER PATTI RADLE, DISTRICT 5.**

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Patti Radle, District 5, has requested that the City Council concur in redirecting \$24,537.45 from the District 5 FY 2000 One-Time Projects Budget of \$48,321.32 for the Inman Christian Center Corridor Revitalization, to provide \$20,391.00 in funding for the construction and one year maintenance of a portable toilet screen enclosure and ADA path of travel in the Amistad Park Project, \$1,146.45 to help offset the costs of building a fence around the VFW Post 4700 baseball field, and \$3,000.00 to the St. Paul Lutheran Child Development Center for the costs associated with providing direct childcare; and

**WHEREAS**, the requested funds would off-set certain expenses which City Council hereby finds support municipal public purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, a sufficient balance exists in the District 5 FY 2000 One-Time Project Budget for the Inman Christian Center Corridor Revitalization to support this request, which balance must now be re-allocated for these purposes; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The request of City Councilmember Patti Radle, District 5, which is attached to this ordinance as Exhibit 1, is hereby approved.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or a designee, is hereby authorized to execute agreements with authorized representatives of the Amistad Park Project, the VFW Post 4700, and the St. Paul Lutheran Child Development Center which set out the terms and conditions for receiving and using public funds. Copies of the fully executed agreements will be attached to this Ordinance upon final execution.

**SECTION 3.** The budget in cost center 7002050001, Council District 5, General Ledger 5201040 entitled "Fees to Professional Contractors," is authorized to be reduced by \$24,537.45.

**SECTION 4.** The budget in Cost Center 7002050016, entitled "Amistad Park Project," General Ledger No. 5407030, entitled "Contributions," is increased by the amount of \$20,391.00, to be

contributed to the Amistad Park Project for the construction of and one year maintenance for a portable toilet screen enclosure with ADA path of travel.

**SECTION 5.** The budget in Cost Center 7002050017, entitled "VFW Post 4700," General Ledger 5407030, entitled "Contributions," is increased by \$1,146.25, to be contributed to VFW Post 4700 to help offset the cost of building a fence for their baseball field.

**SECTION 6.** The budget in Cost Center 7002050018, entitled "St Paul Child Development Center," General Ledger 5407030, entitled "Contributions," is increased by the amount of \$3,000.00, to be contributed to the St. Paul Lutheran Child Development Center to help offset the costs associated with their direct childcare.

**SECTION 7.** Funds in the amount of \$20,391.00 to The Amistad Park Project; \$1,146.45 to the VFW Post 4700; and \$3,000 to St. Paul Child Development Center are authorized to be paid upon full and final execution of the above Agreements, and all funds are encumbered upon issuance of a purchase order.

**SECTION 8:** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 9.** This ordinance shall take effect on the tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) day after the date of passage.


