

AN ORDINANCE 100644

RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM, THE LOCAL BOARD OF THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY'S EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$130,900.00 FOR THE PROVISION OF MORTGAGE AND RENTAL ASSISTANCE BY THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO'S DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY INITIATIVES, COMMUNITY ACTION DIVISION, FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2004 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2005; AND APPROVING A BUDGET AND A PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

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WHEREAS, in accordance with Public Law 101-467, an Emergency Food and Shelter National Board Program was established by Congress to receive federal funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and distribute such funds to local public and private organizations in connection with delivering emergency services to needy FEMA individuals; and

WHEREAS, the local board of the FEMA Emergency Food and Shelter Program allocated the funds to local public and private organizations through the United Way of San Antonio and Bexar County (UW), its fiscal administrator; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio has received funds from the local board of the FEMA Emergency Food and Shelter Program through UW since 1989; and

WHEREAS, the local board of the FEMA Emergency Food and Shelter Program has awarded \$130,900.00 to the City of San Antonio's Department of Community Initiatives, Community Action Division, to provide mortgage assistance, rental assistance, administrative funds and first month's rental assistance for the homeless as they exit emergency shelters to transitional and permanent housing for the period of October 1, 2004 to September 30, 2005; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to ratify the submission of a grant application, accept the funds, approve a budget and a personnel complement and authorize the execution of all documents in connection with the acceptance of said funds; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Submission of a grant application to the local board of the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Emergency Food and Shelter Program for the provision of mortgage and rental assistance by the City of San Antonio's Department of Community Initiatives, Community Action Division for the period October 1, 2004 to September 30, 2005 is ratified. A copy of the application is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to accept a grant in the amount of \$130,900.00 from the local board of the FEMA Emergency Food and Shelter Program for the provision of mortgage and rental assistance by the City of San Antonio's Department of Community Initiatives, Community Action Division for the period of October 1, 2004, to September 30, 2005. The Interim City Manager or his designee or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to execute any and all documents in connection therewith. A copy of the Notice of Award is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment II.


SECTION 3. Fund No. 26-056000 Internal Order No. 138000000316, entitled "05 Emergency Food & Shelter" is designated for use in accounting for said grant and the sum of \$130,900.00 is appropriated in said fund. The Budget and Personnel Complement, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment III, and IV, respectively, are approved.


SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager an Assistant City Manager or an Assistant to the City Manager, may correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP internal orders and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective on and after April 17, 2005.
