

AN ORDINANCE 100680

APPROVING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CASTLERIDGE BETWEEN PINN ROAD AND MILITARY DRIVE WEST FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 11:00 P.M. ON SUNDAY, JUNE 5, 2005, FOR RESURRECTION OF THE LORD CATHOLIC CHURCH'S ANNUAL FESTIVAL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by the **Resurrection of the Lord Catholic Church** to hold its annual church festival on Sunday, June 5, 2005, from 7:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure to vehicular traffic of portions of Castleridge, between Pinn Road and Military Drive West in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

SECTION 3. Funds in the amount of \$75.00 are authorized to be deposited in Fund 11001000 entitled "General Fund", Internal Order Number 223000000082, entitled "TRFC ENG- DES/REV", General Ledger 4408100 entitled "Street-Barricade Fees" when received.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance

SECTION 5. **Resurrection of the Lord Catholic Church** shall be responsible for the following: 1) fulfilling all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) evidencing the street closure to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 6. **Resurrection of the Lord Catholic Church** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage if passed by eight or more votes otherwise this ordinance shall become effective April 24th, 2005.
