

**A RESOLUTION**  
2005-18-17

**APPOINTING THE TEMPORARY BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PROPOSED SAN ANTONIO CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT AND URGING THE TEMPORARY BOARD TO GIVE STRONG CONSIDERATION TO THE CITY COUNCIL'S PRIORITIES IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF A TWO-YEAR CRIME CONTROL PLAN AND TWO-YEAR BUDGET PLAN; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN RON H. SEGOVIA, DISTRICT 3.**

**WHEREAS**, on March 10, 2005, the San Antonio City Council passed and approved Ordinance No. 100539, proposing the creation of a Crime Control and Prevention District ("District") pursuant to Section 363.051 of the Crime Control and Prevention District Act ("Act"); and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed San Antonio Crime Control and Prevention District is dedicated to crime reduction programs and the adoption of a proposed local sales and use tax at the rate of 1/8 of one percent; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 363.052(a) of the Act requires that the City Council appoint seven persons that reside in the proposed district to serve as temporary directors of the district, within 60 days of the date the district is proposed; and

**WHEREAS**, the temporary board of directors is charged by state law with the responsibility of developing a two-year crime control plan and two-year budget plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the temporary board of directors is also charged by state law to give proper notice and hold a public hearing to gather input from the public prior to the board's adoption of the two-year crime control plan and two-year budget plan; and

**WHEREAS**, once a two-year crime control plan and two-year budget plan is adopted, a majority of the temporary board of directors may order an election for the purpose of allowing voters to vote for or against the creation of the Crime Control and Prevention District and the imposition of a sales and use tax to finance the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Antonio City Council, through this resolution, appoints the members of the temporary board of directors and also expresses its desire, as a whole, for the temporary board to develop a crime control plan and budget plan that reflects the priorities of the City Council and the citizens of San Antonio; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Section 363.052(a) the Crime Control and Prevention District Act, the City Council appoints the following persons, who reside in the proposed District, which is comprised of the City of San Antonio city limits, to serve as temporary directors of the San Antonio Crime Control and Prevention District:

2. Jimmy Drennan
3. Ray Hamilton
4. Ethel Nelson

5. Art Trevino
6. Robert Marbut
7. Joe Webb

**SECTION 2.** The temporary board of directors of the proposed San Antonio Crime Control and Prevention District shall elect one of the directors as presiding officer of the board not later than the 15<sup>th</sup> day after the date of the appointments, pursuant to Section 363.052(b) of the Act, and thereafter develop a two-year crime control plan and two-year budget plan that dedicates all funding to crime control and crime prevention programs and projects that address both City Council priorities and citizen concerns, including, but not limited to, the following:


- Additional police officers for specialized units and activities, and neighborhood patrols;
- Funding for both capital and specialized equipment to enhance City and park police operations;
- Support for community policing and crime prevention programs to both improve and expand program application and effectiveness;
- Funding for programs and projects designed to reduce gang and domestic violence;
- Funding for elderly and youth-oriented crime prevention initiatives.


**SECTION 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately if approved by eight (8) or more affirmative votes; otherwise, said resolution shall be effective on and after the tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) day from the date of passage hereof.
