

AN ORDINANCE 100785

WAIVING ALL PARKS AND RECREATION FEES, EXCEPT FOR THE REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT, INCURRED BY THE TEXAS EMANCIPATION DAY COMMISSION, INC. ASSOCIATED WITH THE USE OF PITTMAN-SULLIVAN PARK FOR THE JUNETEENTH CELEBRATION ON JUNE 18, 2005 WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT THE BASEBALL DIAMOND WILL NOT BE USED, AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMEMBER JOEL WILLIAMS, DISTRICT 2.

WHEREAS, City Councilmember Joel Williams, District 2, has submitted a Council Consideration Request (CCR) memorandum directing staff to waive certain rental fees in connection with the Juneteenth Celebration to be held on June 18, 2005 in Pittman-Sullivan Park to be hosted by the Texas Emancipation Day Commission, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Juneteenth holiday celebrates a great day in history, June 19, 1865, which is when, thirty months after President Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation, General Gordon Granger of the Federal Occupation Troops issued General Order No. 3 - Emancipation, in Galveston Bay; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:




Section 2. All other City regulations regarding events in Pittman-Sullivan Park shall be enforced as required under City Code and Parks Department regulations.
