

AN ORDINANCE **100784**

WAIVING CERTAIN RENTAL FEES IN CONNECTION WITH TEJANO CONJUNTO FESTIVAL, WHICH IS HOSTED BY THE GUADALUPE CULTURAL ARTS CENTER, SCHEDULED TO TAKE PLACE AT ROSEDALE PARK FROM MAY 4 THROUGH MAY 7, 2005, ON A ONE-TIME BASIS AND EXCLUDING THE \$1,500 DEPOSIT, IN AN AMOUNT TOTALING APPROXIMATELY \$3,700.00; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMEMBER PATTI RADLE, DISTRICT 5.

WHEREAS, City Councilmember Patti Radle, District 5, has submitted a Council Consideration Request (CCR) memorandum directing staff to waive certain rental fees in connection with Tejano Conjunto Festival, which is hosted by the Guadalupe Cultural Arts Center scheduled to take place at Rosedale Park from May 4 through May 7, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Guadalupe Cultural Arts Center is a local non-profit organization with an established history of working with the City of San Antonio and its citizens; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1. In consideration of the public purpose being served by the Tejano Conjunto Festival event, presented by the Guadalupe Cultural Arts Center and scheduled to take place at Rosedale Park from May 4, 2005 through May 7, 2005, City staff is hereby directed to waive reservation fees totaling approximately \$3,700.00 in connection with this event.

Section 2. All other City regulations regarding events in Rosedale Park shall be enforced as required under City Code and Parks Department regulations.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective on and after May 15, 2005.




