

AN ORDINANCE 100926

DESIGNATING SATRANS JOINT VENTURE AS THE OPERATOR OF A FOR HIRE SHARED-RIDE AIRPORT SHUTTLE SERVICE, BETWEEN THE AIRPORT, DOWNTOWN AND OTHER DESTINATIONS; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SATRANS JOINT VENTURE FOR A PRIMARY TERM OF FIVE (5) YEARS COMMENCING ON JUNE 1, 2005 AND, UPON MUTUAL AGREEMENT, FOR FIVE ADDITIONAL PERIODS OF ONE YEAR EACH; WHICH AGREEMENT PROVIDES THAT THE CITY WILL RECEIVE THE GREATER OF A MINIMUM ANNUAL GUARANTEE OF \$175,000.00 OR FIFTEEN PERCENT 15% OF GROSS REVENUES, INCLUDING REVENUE RECEIVED FROM ADVERTISING SALES.

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WHEREAS, proposals were solicited by the City of San Antonio for the operation of a for hire shared-ride Airport shuttle service, between the San Antonio International Airport, downtown San Antonio and other destinations; and

WHEREAS, two qualifying proposals were received in response to the City's Request for Proposals, one from Star Shuttle, Inc. and one from SATRANS Joint Venture (SATRANS) and each was rated by a seven (7) member selection committee established for that purpose, giving consideration to price, financial integrity of respondent, experience and qualifications of respondent, management, operation and service plans, and compliance with SEBDA requirements; and

WHEREAS, based on the ratings, the selection committee determined the proposal by SATRANS to be the best qualified proposal; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to designate SATRANS for the operation of a for hire shared-ride Airport shuttle, service, between the San Antonio International Airport, downtown San Antonio and other destinations; and to authorize the negotiation and execution of a contract with said firm; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The proposal of SATRANS Joint Venture submitted to the City of San Antonio on February 2, 2005 in response to its Request for Proposals for the Airport Shuttle Concession is hereby accepted, except to the extent such terms shall be modified or conflict with the final Agreement between the parties. A copy of such proposal is on file in the Office of the Aviation Director and is incorporated herein by reference. All other proposals for the Airport Shuttle Service Concession shall be rejected upon the execution of a contract by all parties.

SECTION 2. The interim City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement with SATRANS Joint Venture in a form substantially the same in form and content as the one attached hereto as Attachment 1 for a primary term of five years commencing June 1, 2005 and, upon mutual agreement, for five additional periods of one year each. Pursuant to the Agreement the City will receive the greater of a minimum annual guarantee of \$175,000.00 or 15% of gross revenues, including revenue received from advertising sales; and for the rental of not fewer than one curbside ticket booth location in each terminal and the option to rent an in-terminal ticket booth in each terminal at \$280.00 each per month.

SECTION 3. Funds are authorized to be deposited in Internal Order 233000000084, General Ledger 4405921, entitled "GT Processing Fees", Fund 51001000 entitled "Airport Operations & Maintenance Account".

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance for the City of San Antonio for the City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.
