

AN ORDINANCE **100909**

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH UNGERBOECK SYSTEMS, INC. FOR DATABASE MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE UTILIZED BY THE ALAMODOME, CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU AND CONVENTION FACILITIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005; AUTHORIZING PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,473.75 FOR RELATED SERVICES FOR THE ALAMODOME FROM MARCH 2005 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2005; RATIFYING PRIOR PAYMENT, FROM FISCAL YEAR 2001-2002 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$120,616.00 BY THE CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU AND CONVENTION FACILITIES; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.

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WHEREAS, in July 1999, City Council approved a professional services agreement (“Agreement”) in the amount of \$168,639.27 with Ungerboeck Systems, Inc. (“Ungerboeck”) for the purchase of Electronic Booking Management Software (“EBMS”) for the Convention Facilities Department and Convention and Visitors Bureau (“CVB”) and the Agreement was amended by City Council in December 2000 for necessary additional services in the amount of \$57,160.73 and again in March 2004, in the amount of \$31,995.00, to allow the Alamodome access to EBMS and the ability to share booking and other information with the CVB and Convention Facilities Department; and

WHEREAS, the Convention Facilities Department, CVB and Alamodome have each been responsible for the administration and implementation of the software for their respective departments; and

WHEREAS, since October 2001, maintenance services have been extended by both the Convention Facilities Department and CVB and the Alamodome’s amendment in 2004 encompassed maintenance for the period of March 11, 2004 through March 10, 2005; and

WHEREAS, this proposed Ordinance provides for consolidation of all maintenance into one maintenance agreement by authorizing the execution of a maintenance agreement for Fiscal Year 2004-2005, authorizing payment for related services for the Alamodome in the amount of \$3,473.75 and ratifying prior maintenance payments, from Fiscal Year 2001-2002 through Fiscal Year 2004-2005, by the Convention Facilities Department and CVB in the amount of \$120,616.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The terms and conditions of a maintenance agreement with Ungerboeck Systems, Inc. for Database Management Software utilized by the Alamodome, Convention and Visitors Bureau and Convention Facilities for Fiscal Year 2004-2005 are hereby authorized and approved. Payment in the amount of \$3,473.75 for related services for the Alamodome from March 2005 through September 30, 2005 is hereby authorized and prior payments, from Fiscal Year 2001-2002 through Fiscal Year 2004-2005, in the amount of \$120,616.00 by the Convention and Visitors Bureau and Convention Facilities are hereby ratified.

SECTION 2. The Interim City Manager or his designee is authorized, for a sixty (60)-day period following the effective date of this Ordinance, to execute a maintenance agreement with Ungerboeck. A copy of said maintenance agreement, previously executed by Ungerboeck, is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment I.

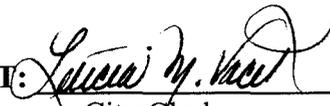
SECTION 3. Funds in the amount of \$3,473.75 are authorized to be encumbered in Cost Center 4502010001, General Ledger 5304075, entitled "Commodities-Computer Software", Fund 29016000, entitled "HOT/Alamodome" and made payable to Ungerboeck Systems, Inc.

SECTION 4. Payments in the amount of \$120,616.00 by the Convention and Visitors Bureau and Convention Facilities, from Fiscal Year 2001-2002 through Fiscal Year 2004-2005, are hereby ratified.

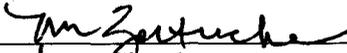
SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth day after passage hereof.
