

AN ORDINANCE      100895

**APPROVING THE TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE OF NORTH MEDINA BETWEEN MORALES AND WEST MARTIN ON FRIDAY, JUNE 24, 2005 FROM 8:30 A.M. UNTIL 10:00 A.M. IN ORDER FOR THE AMERICAN GI FORUM VETERANS RESIDENTIAL CENTER TO HOLD ITS GRAND OPENING.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The street closure requested by the **American GI Forum Veterans Residential Center** to hold its Grand Opening Ceremonies on Friday, June 24, 2005 from 8:30 a.m. until 10:00 a.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

**SECTION 2.** The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of N. Medina, from Morales to West Martin, is hereby authorized during the event.

**SECTION 3.** Funds in the amount of \$75.00 are authorized to be deposited in Internal Order Number 223000000082, General Ledger 4408100, entitled "Street - Barricade Fees", Fund 11001000 entitled "General Fund".

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** The **American GI Forum Veterans Residential Center** shall be responsible for the following: 1) fulfilling all insurance requirements, paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 2) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 3) evidencing the street closure to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 4) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage if passed by eight or more votes otherwise this ordinance shall become effective May 29, 2005.


