

AN ORDINANCE **100894**

**APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF ST. MARY'S HOUSTON, AND MAIN STREETS IN DOWNTOWN FROM 4:15 P.M. UNTIL 5:30 P.M. ON SUNDAY, MAY 29, 2005 FOR THE EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION SPONSORED BY THE EUCHARISTIC ADORATION OF SAN ANTONIO.**

**WHEREAS**, the **Eucharistic Adoration of San Antonio** has requested the approval of a parade permit to hold its Eucharistic Procession on Sunday, May 29, 2005 from 4:15 p.m. until 5:30 p.m., a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit A**; and

**WHEREAS**, the **Eucharistic Adoration of San Antonio** has requested closure of certain streets near 202 N. St. Mary's (St. Mary's Catholic Church), as listed in the above referenced permit; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The parade permit requested by the **Eucharistic Adoration of San Antonio** to hold its Eucharistic Procession on Sunday, May 29, 2005 from 4:15 p.m. until 5:30 p.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity. City staff is authorized to close City of San Antonio streets listed in the parade permit route, and to take reasonable and necessary steps to implement this ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** The **Eucharistic Adoration of San Antonio** shall be responsible for the following: 1) fulfilling all insurance requirements, paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 2) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 3) evidencing the street closure to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 4) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

**SECTION 3.** Funds in the amount of \$25.00 are authorized to be deposited in Internal Order Number 223000000082, General Ledger 4408100, entitled "Street - Barricade Fees", Fund 11001000 entitled "General Fund".

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage if passed by eight or more votes otherwise this ordinance shall become effective May 29, 2005.


