

AN ORDINANCE 100890

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT AMENDMENT WITH THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT TO REVISE THE NUMBER OF CLIENTS TO BE SERVED THROUGH THE ST. MARY'S SCHOOL OF LAW, LAWYERING FOR THE HOMELESS PROGRAM, IN CONNECTION WITH THE 2002 SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROGRAM.

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WHEREAS, on May 22, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 97663, the City Council authorized the execution of a Grant Agreement with the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to fund the St. Mary's School of Law, Lawyering for the Homeless Program, in connection with the 2002 Supportive Housing Program; and

WHEREAS, St. Mary's School of Law was contracted to provide legal services to 250 homeless clients, at any point in time; and

WHEREAS, St. Mary's School of Law projects to serve 250 homeless clients during the contract period but will not serve more than 83 homeless clients at any point in time; and

WHEREAS, HUD accepts the St. Mary's School of Law clarification of the number of homeless clients to be served and now requires a Grant Agreement Amendment reflecting the revised projection of clients to be served at any point in time; and

WHEREAS, HUD requires execution of said Grant Agreement Amendment prior to the expiration of the current contract on May 31, 2005 and will not renew said contract until said Grant Agreement Amendment has been executed; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement Amendment with the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) revising the number of clients to be served from 250 to 83 at any point in time through the St. Mary's School of Law, Lawyering for the Homeless Program, in connection with the 2002 Supportive Housing Program. A copy of said Grant Agreement Amendment is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective on and after May 29, 2005.
