

AN ORDINANCE

**ACCEPTING THE LOW, RESPONSIVE BIDS SUBMITTED BY HOLT CAT, INC., ITEM 1B FOR A TOTAL OF \$283,076.00; TEXANA MACHINERY LTD., ITEMS 2 AND 4 FOR A TOTAL OF \$392,400.00; FOUR SEASONS EQUIPMENT, INC., ITEM 3 FOR A TOTAL OF \$78,940.00; AND COOPER EQUIPMENT CO., ITEMS 5 AND 6 FOR A TOTAL OF \$554,382.00 TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC WORKS STORM WATER DIVISION AND STREET MAINTENANCE DIVISION WITH HEAVY EQUIPMENT FOR A COMBINED TOTAL COST OF \$1,308,798.00.**

**WHEREAS**, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Public Works Storm Water Division and Street Maintenance Division with heavy equipment which will be utilized for street maintenance and repairs, and channel and river cleaning; and

**WHEREAS**, the bids submitted by RDO Equipment Company, items 1B, 3 & 4; Anderson Machinery San Antonio, Inc., items 2 & 3; Romeo Equipment Company, item 3; and Waukesha-Pearce Industries, Inc., items 3 & 4 failed to meet the City specifications; and

**WHEREAS**, Holt Cat, Inc., item 1B, Texana Machinery Ltd., items 2 and 4, Four Seasons Equipment, Inc., item 3, and Cooper Equipment Co., items 5 and 6 were the low responsive bidders for a combined total cost of \$1,308,798.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The low, responsive bids of Holt Cat, Inc., item 1B, Texana Machinery Ltd., items 2 and 4, Four Seasons Equipment, Inc., item 3, and Cooper Equipment Co., items 5 and 6 to provide the City of San Antonio Public Works Storm Water Division and Street Maintenance Division with heavy equipment for a combined total cost of \$1,308,798.00 are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. The bids and bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

**SECTION 2.** It has been found and declared that the low bids of RDO Equipment Company, items 1B, 3 & 4; Anderson Machinery San Antonio, Inc., items 2 & 3; Romeo Equipment Company, item 3; and Waukesha-Pearce Industries, Inc., items 3 & 4 failed to meet the City's specifications.

**SECTION 3.** Funds were appropriated in the FY 2004-2005 Budget and the funds will be encumbered in Fund 72001000, entitled "Equipment Renewal & Replacement" upon issuance of a purchase order.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall take effect June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2005.
