

AN ORDINANCE 100929

**ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF VARIOUS COMPANIES TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO WITH VARIOUS TYPES OF COMMODITIES AND SERVICES ON AN ANNUAL CONTRACT BASIS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006 FOR AN ESTIMATED COMBINED ANNUAL COST OF \$1,337,055.00 TO INCLUDE CONTRACTS FOR: CATERPILLAR EARTHMOVING, CONSTRUCTION & PAVING EQUIPMENT PARTS & SERVICE; HEAVY DUTY VOLVO/WHITE/GMC AND MEDIUM HEAVY DUTY FORD TRUCK PARTS & SERVICE; GRASS SOD; ORACLE DATABASE SOFTWARE AND SERVICE; BROWN MOWER PARTS; PURCHASE & REPAIR OF FEDERAL APD PARTS FOR PARKING GARAGES; AND NEW HOLLAND PRODUCTS, HOWSE, TERRAIN KING MECHANICAL MOWER, OKADA, BRADCO & MORBARK CHIPPER & FIAT-ALLIS EQUIPMENT PARTS & SERVICE.**

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**WHEREAS**, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

**WHEREAS**, this group of contracts represents a portion of approximately two hundred and fifty (250) annual contracts that will be brought before City Council throughout the remainder of the fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, these bids are from various companies to furnish the City with Caterpillar earthmoving, construction & paving equipment parts & service; heavy duty Volvo/White/GMC and medium heavy duty Ford truck parts & service; grass sod; Oracle database software and service; Brown mower parts; purchase & repair of Federal APD parts for parking garages; and New Holland products, Howse, Terrain King mechanical mower, Okada, Bradco & Morbark chipper & Fiat-Allis equipment parts & service; and

**WHEREAS**, Section I of the attachment consists of six (6) competitive bids in which awards are recommended to the lowest bidders; and

**WHEREAS**, Section II of the attachment consists of one (1) contract in which award was recommended to a bidder other than the lowest bidder because the low bid failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, it is estimated that approximately \$20,000,000.00 will be spent on annual contracts during the 2005-2006 fiscal year and such expenditures will be in accordance with the 2005-2006 budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The bids of various companies to furnish the City with Caterpillar earthmoving, construction & paving equipment parts & service; heavy duty Volvo/White/GMC and medium heavy duty Ford truck parts & service; grass sod; Oracle database software and service; Brown mower parts; purchase & repair of Federal APD parts for parking garages; and New Holland products, Howse, Terrain King mechanical mower, Okada, Bradco & Morbark chipper & Fiat-Allis equipment parts & service on an annual contract basis, are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. The bids and bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

**SECTION 2.** It has been found and declared that the low bid Anderson Machinery San Antonio, Inc. for Ford New Holland products, Howse, Terrain King mechanical mower, Okada, Bradco & Morbark chipper & Fiat-Allis equipment parts & service failed to meet the City's specifications.

**SECTION 3.** Funding will not be expended by this ordinance. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY2004-2005 and the FY2005-2006 budget approved by the City Council.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2005.
