

AN ORDINANCE 101035

**APPROVING THE TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE OF NORTHBOUND LEGEND LANE, FROM CAMP BULLIS TO WITTENBURG, AND SOUTHBOUND LEGEND LANE, FROM CAMP BULLIS TO SINGING FOREST, AND LA SIERRA BOULEVARD, FROM CAMP BULLIS ROAD TO WITTENBURG, ON MONDAY, JULY 4, 2005 FROM 6:00 P.M. UNTIL 11:59 P.M., AS REQUESTED BY CROWNRIIDGE OF TEXAS OWNERS ASSOCIATION.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The temporary street closure of Northbound Legend Lane, from Camp Bullis to Wittenburg, and Southbound Legend Lane, from Camp Bullis to Singing Forest, and La Sierra Boulevard, from Camp Bullis Road to Wittenburg, as requested by **Crownridge of Texas Owners Association, Inc.**, on Monday, July 4, 2005, from 6:00 p.m. until 11:59 p. m., is hereby authorized. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

**SECTION 2.** The Interim City Manager or his designee, is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the government.

**SECTION 3.** Funds in the amount of \$225.00 are authorized to be deposited in Fund 11001000 entitled "General Fund", Internal Order Number 223000000082, entitled "TRFC ENG- DES/REV", General Ledger 4408100 entitled "Street-Barricade Fees" when received.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance for the City of San Antonio for the City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 5. Crownridge of Texas Owners Association, Inc.** shall be responsible for the following:  
a) fulfilling all insurance requirements, paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges;  
b) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments;  
c) evidencing the street closure to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic; and  
d) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

**SECTION 6. Crownridge of Texas Owners Association, Inc** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street rights of way.

**SECTION 7.** This ordinance shall be effective on June 26, 2005.

STREET CLOSURE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Applicant (undersigned) has requested the temporary closure of certain streets to vehicular traffic in order to hold a special event, to wit: La Sierra + Camp Bullis and Legend Lane + Camp Bullis (North + South) (street name)

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio requires the execution of this agreement establishing the legal obligations of the person or organization requesting said street closure before reviewing said request;

NOW THEREFORE: The undersigned, by requesting this special use of a public right-of-way agrees to the following terms and conditions:

TERMS

1. The user organizations will provide signs, barriers, and off duty police personnel as may be required by the Police Department or the Public Works Department for the requested closure, to protect participants in the activities, or rerouted traffic.
2. Pay all fees and license charges, and be responsible for clean up afterwards.
3. Assume all risk inherent in this undertaking, and to identify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all cost, liability, or damage arising from or growing out of the requested usage.
4. A 20-foot wide unobstructed lane must be maintained through the entire length of the right-of-way closure for emergency vehicle access.
5. If the requesting party elects to set up and maintain traffic control devices (including barricades), they must comply with the training requirements of section 6A-6 of the *Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices*.
